Progress:

Nate has long banked with Enterprise Bank, which frequently partners with The Progress Fund. The two lenders combined on a \$780,700 financing package to back the purchase and renovation of the convent.

Impact:

The 11-suite Connellsville Convent can book a single cyclist, a wedding party of dozens and anything in between. Combined with the Comfort Inn and event center/restaurant Nate is developing, it allows the trail town to accommodate any small-to-midsize event. Convent guests enjoy a range of settings, from the cozy man-cave basement to the luxurious upper-floor suites. Nate says unique experiences like that generate buzz: "Hey, we went to Connellsville, we biked the GAP trail – and while we were there we stayed at a convent."

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
